

Riesling Federspiel Kirnberg

Terroir: primary rock, weathering stone

Age of Vines: 25 years

Harvest date: 24th and 25th of September 2012

Vinification:

The grapes get crushed before pressing and the juice ferments cooled in stainless steel tanks. After 4 weeks on the lees and filtering the wine got bottled in spring 2013.

Category:

This classic dry wine is distinguished by a strong, nuance-rich character. Federspiel® wines feature a must weight of at least 17° KMW and an alcohol content of between 11.5% and 12.5% by volume. The name Federspiel refers back to the times of falconry, when this favourite form of noble hunting was practiced in the Wachau.

Analysis:

alcohol: 12,0 % vol

acidity: 6,6 g/l

residual sugar: 3,3 g/l

extract: 22,9 g/l
